PRESCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

ALL STUDENTS SEND:

- Back pack large enough to pack a library book & clearly marked w/ child's name on the outside (so the bag can be quickly recognized)
- 1 thermos for packing a drink (labeled)
- 6 glue sticks

LAST NAMES BEGINNING W/ LETTERS

A - M SEND:

- straws
- 2 bags of napkins
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 box of tissues
- 2 refills of wipes

LAST NAMES BEGINNING W/ LETTERS

N - Z SEND:

- 1 small set of water colors (do not label w/name)
- 1 large bottle of washable poster paint (any color)
- play dough-any amount will be helpful

MARK CHILD'S NAME ON THESE:

- book bag
- 2 pocket folders
- headphones- These can be purchased at Walmart or Dollar Stores. Please put them in a quart or gallon sized bag labeled with your child's name
- 2 marble cover composition books
- 3 inch binder (3 ring) – This will hold your child's portfolio through 8th grade.

THESE WILL BE SHARED ITEMS. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON THEM.

- 6 glue sticks- any size
- 8 pack of washable markers - classic colors
- 1 bottle of washable white glue - any size
- (2) 8 count boxes of crayons
- 1 box of tissues

LEVEL 1-2 SUPPLY LIST

MARK CHILD'S NAME ON THESE:

- book bag
- 3 pocket folders
- headphones- These can be purchased at Walmart or Dollar Stores. Please put them in a quart or gallon sized bag labeled with your child's name

- 3 marble cover composition books
 - Pencil box with the following supplies (for art class)
 - 2 sharpened pencils and erasers
 - scissors
 - 2 glue sticks
 - markers and crayons

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL BE SHARED. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON THEM.

- 3 glue sticks- any size
- 8 pack of washable markers - classic colors
- 1 bottle of washable white glue - any size
- (2) 8 count boxes of crayons – You can send 24 count if they are cheaper than 8 count.
- 2 boxes of tissues
- package of yellow #2 pencils
- pack of pencil top erasers

THINGS WE COULD USE IF YOU WANT TO DONATE....

- Disinfectant wipes for tables
- Hand sanitizer
- wet wipes
- zipper gallon, sandwich, or snack size baggies

LEVEL 3-4 SUPPLY LIST

- One 2' 3 ring binder r with a slide-in "window" on the front
- One 1/2" 3 ring binder
- 8 Two-pocket folders with three prongs in the following colors: purple, green, red, orange, yellow, blue, orange, and black. (These can be bought at Wal-mart fairly inexpensively, for about 25 cents per folder, during July and August.)
In addition, if your child would like a folder with a picture on it, that's fine.

- 6 composition books – Mark with name
- 5 wired theme books (70 pages) – Mark with name
- scissors
- crayons
- markers
- colored pencils
- two or three packages #2 pencils
- pencil box (don't make this too big, should be able to fit inside the cubby space)
- 6 glue sticks
- 3 boxes of tissue
- 3 containers of sanitizer wipes (to clean off tables)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

MATH:

- 1 – 1 inch binder
- 1 – bound composition book
- 1 – pocket folder
- Loose leaf paper in binder
- 1 – package graph paper
- Calculator optional

SOCIAL STUDIES:

- 1 – 1 inch binder
- 2 – pocket folders

SCIENCE:

- 1 – spiral notebook
- 1 – 1 inch binder

- 1 – bound composition book
- 1 – pocket folder
- 1 – pair of dishwashing gloves
- 1 – package of index cards, lined or unlined.

LANGUAGE ARTS:

- Two pocket folders
- One bound composition book
- One 1-2 inch binder
- Dividers for the binder (at least 5)

TECHNOLOGY:

- One pocket folder
